Mr. Jackson has been featured in an HBO Movie titled "Gang Wars: Bangin' in Little Rock," and now goes around the country speaking to youth and parents about the dangers of gangs. Mr. Jackson will be showing part of the movie, and will speak about his experiences and struggles with escaping the gang lifestyle.

Workshops

The morning will be comprised of two sessions, with a youth track and an adult track. The youth sessions will cover topics of self esteem, empowerment, and personal choices. The adult sessions will cover topics of identifying your skills and talents, creating a vision for yourself, and how to start a successful business.

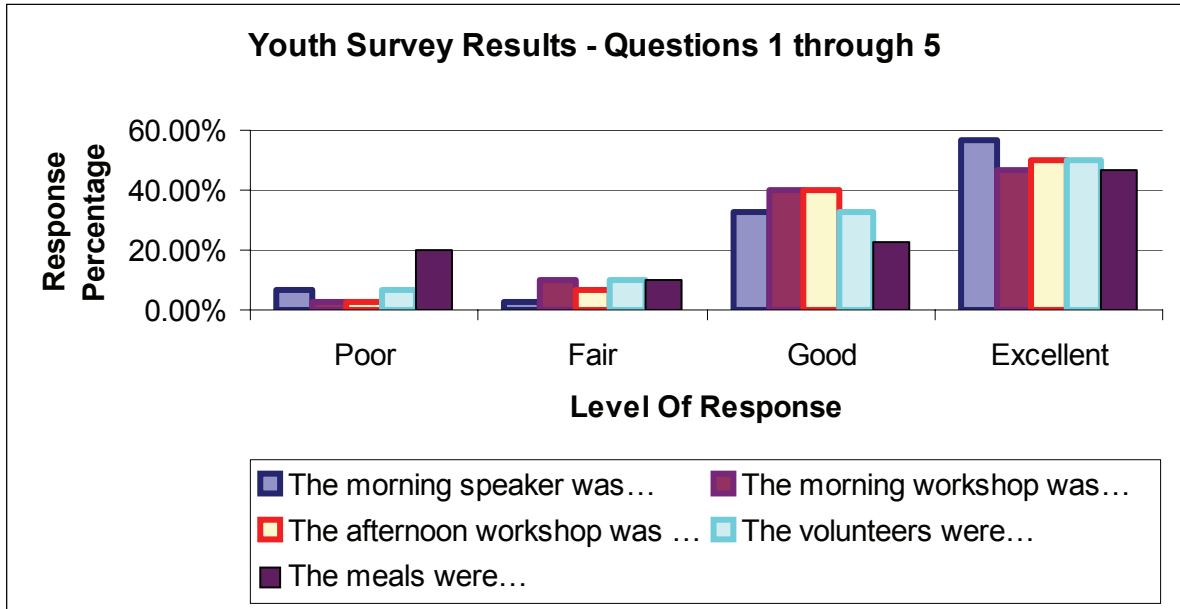

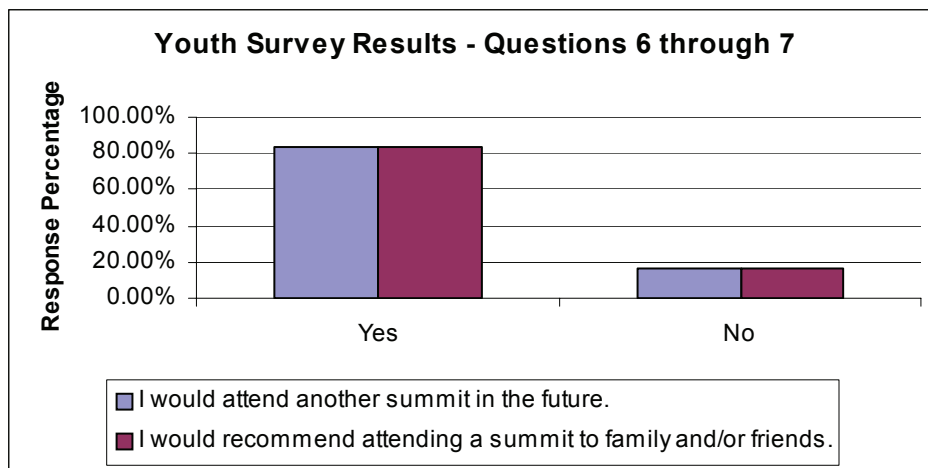

Youth Survey Results - 30 Responses



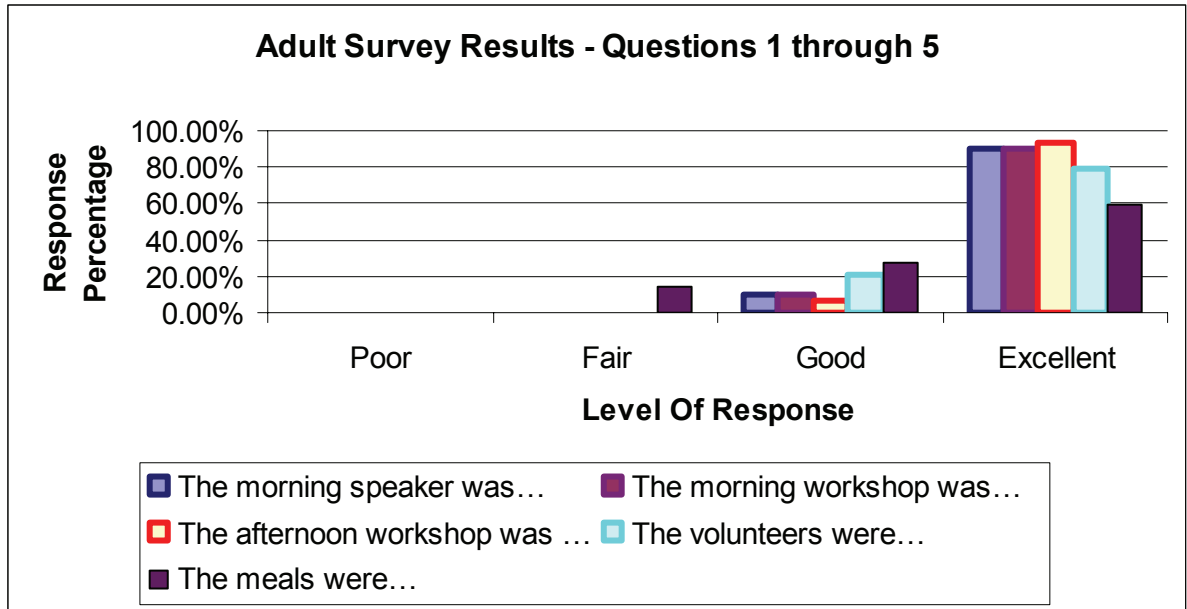

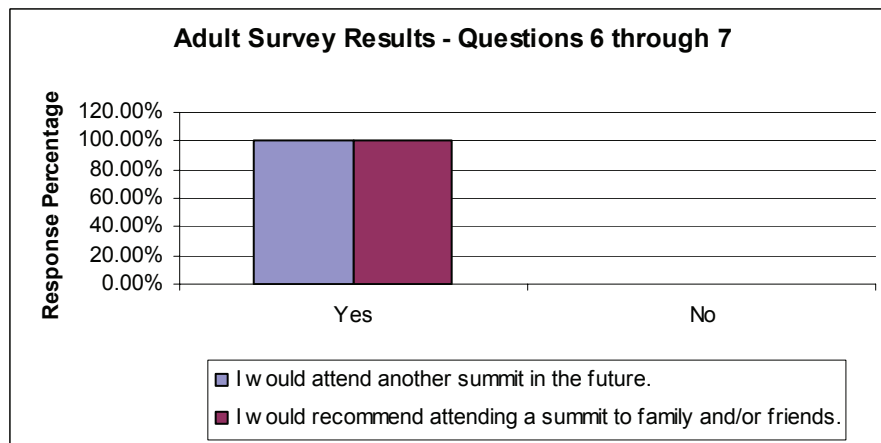

Adult Survey Results - 29 Responses



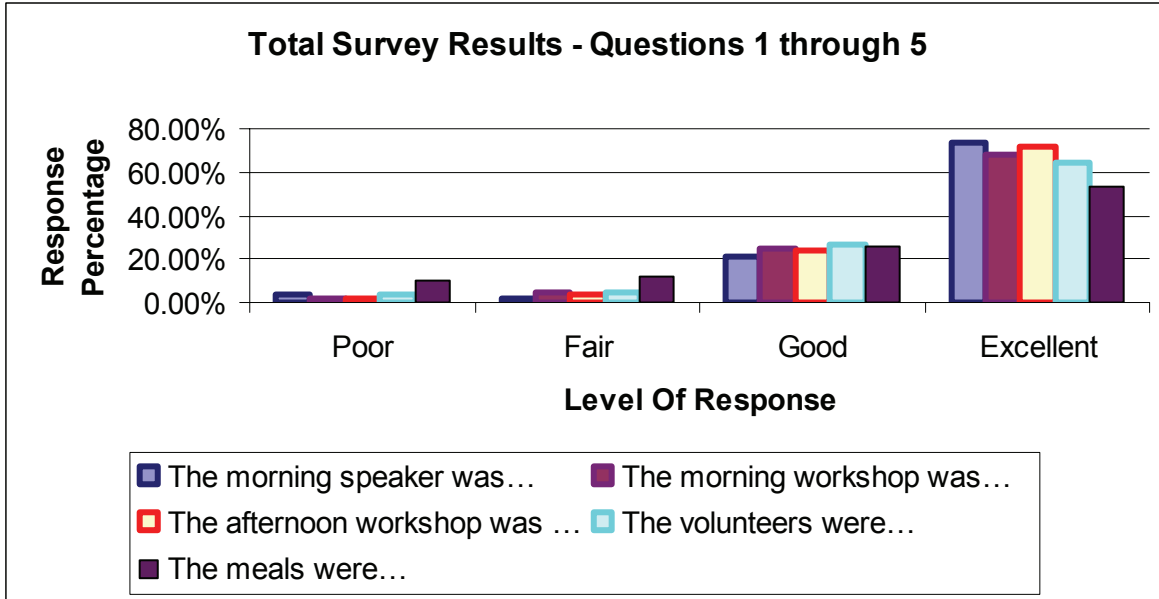

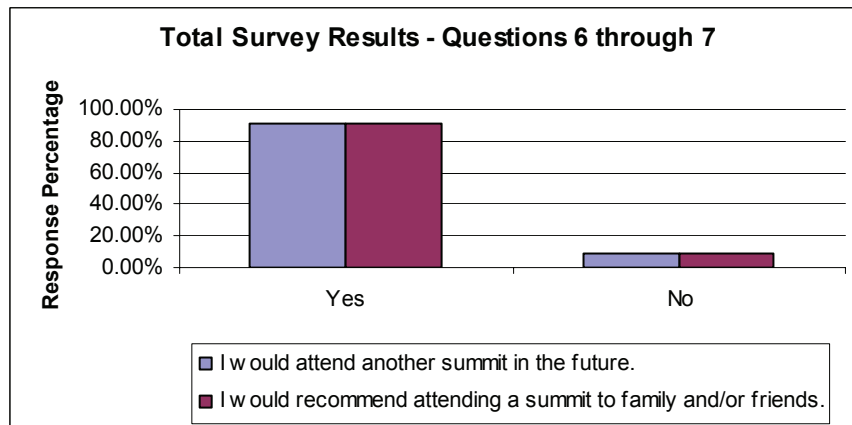
